Research Grants – Agency Financial Reporting Deadline March 31, 2017

March 31st is the fiscal year-end for all federally and provincially funded programs (NSERC, SSHRC, CRC). Please ensure that all charges for the period April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017, (travel expenses/claims, invoices, etc.) are submitted to [Karin](#) no later than 4:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, March 21, 2017**.

Professional Expense Reimbursement (PER) – Deadline March 28, 2017

2017 [Professional Expense Reimbursement \(PER\)](#) is now available. The deadline for submitting expenses against your 2016 PER allowance is **March 31, 2017**; receipts can be dated up to March 31, 2017. Please give your original receipts, which can be returned to you, to Karin by Tuesday, **March 28**, for review and approval by the Chair. Once approved by Chair, Karin will submit your PER applications (with original receipts) for processing. Note that PER claims can be made throughout the year (minimum submission amount = \$500).
